



## RATE SCHEDULE 400 LARGE POWER

### AVAILABILITY:

Available in all areas served by the District's distribution system where adequate capacity exists.

### APPLICABILITY:

Applicable for any lighting and power use having an established measured demand of 50 KW or more, including loads that have decreased, making them no longer eligible for schedule 500 or 600. Not available for residential, or any single metered, mixed load that contains residential.

Also subject to the District's "Rate Schedule Qualifications & Demand Calculations."

### TYPE OF SERVICE:

Sixty cycle, alternating current at such phase and voltage as the District may have available, metered for energy and demand.

### MONTHLY RATE:

Basic Charge:	Demand minimum billing
Energy Charge:	\$0.07063 per KWH
Demand Charge:	\$250.00 per month for the first 50 KW or less \$ 5.50 per KW for each additional KW

### DETERMINATION OF BILLING DEMAND:

The billing demand shall be the maximum average kilowatt load used by the consumer for any period of thirty (30) consecutive minutes during the month for which the bill is rendered as indicated or recorded by a demand meter.

### OTHER ELECTRIC CHARGES:

A line-item charge may be added to utility billing statements for any required Federal, State, or Local charges levied against the District, including but not limited to the City Utility Tax imposed upon electric sales within the City of Republic.

### TERMS OF PAYMENT:

Electric service accounts are due and payable upon receipt and become delinquent on the 16<sup>th</sup> of the month following the billing date. A 1% penalty, with a minimum charge of \$10.00, will be assessed on all accounts with a past due balance on the 21<sup>st</sup> of each month.
