



## RATE SCHEDULE 600 PRIMARY INDUSTRIAL

### AVAILABILITY:

Available in areas where the District's 34.5kV system is available, and where adequate capacity exists. Also available to loads connected to the BPA 115kV system as individual "Points of Delivery".

### APPLICABILITY:

Applicable for any lighting and power use having an established measured demand of 500 KW or more.

Also Subject to the "Rate Schedule Qualifications & Demand Calculations."

### TYPE OF SERVICE:

Three-phase at available primary voltages (34.5kV and above). Metered for demand, energy and var-hours. The consumer shall supply, own, and maintain all equipment on the load side of the district's primary connection (primary termination).

### MONTHLY RATE:

Basic Charge:	Demand minimum billing
Energy Charge:	\$0.06037 per KWH
Demand Charge:	\$2,500.00 per month for the first 500 KW or less \$5.50 per KW for each additional KW.

### DETERMINATION OF BILLING DEMAND:

The billing demand shall be the maximum average kilowatt load used by the consumer for any period of thirty (30) consecutive minutes during the month for which the bill is rendered as indicated or recorded by a demand meter.

### POWER FACTOR ADJUSTMENT:

The consumer agrees to maintain unity power factor as nearly as practicable. The demand for billing purposes will be adjusted for power factors less than 97% lagging. Such adjustments will be made by increasing the billing demand by 1% for each 1% the power factor is lagging 97%.

OVER

OTHER ELECTRIC CHARGES:

A line-item charge may be added to utility billing statements for any required Federal, State, or Local charges levied against the District, including but not limited to the City Utility Tax imposed upon electric sales within the City of Republic.

TERM OF PAYMENT AND LATE PAYMENT CHARGE:

Electric service accounts are due and payable upon receipt and become delinquent on the 16<sup>th</sup> of the month following the billing date. A 1% penalty, with a minimum charge of \$10.00, will be assessed on all accounts with a past due balance on the 21<sup>st</sup> of each month.
